### Description of the graduate's profile

#### General characteristics

The graduate in the study programme:

- acquires knowledge of the basis, structure, perspectives and trends in the security public administration services progression, which enables him/her to understand the tasks, content, forms, methods and his powers within the tasks fulfilment.

Graduates can hold positions of: administrative worker – specialist or manager of security public administration services with the middle and senior management of local civil service and local government within the field of general interior administration, fire protection, civil protection, defence and crisis management.
