Goals of the conference:

Nowadays, one the serious problem, which all the countries of the international community are encountering, is an enormous increase in organized crime. We can notice that the trend of the criminal groups is to commit a crime by a plan, systematically, purposefully, and on a long-term basis at the same time respecting the rules of strict conspiracy and measures against detection and criminal punishment.

Besides huge social and economic consequences, the organized crime can have a political impact because strong criminal groups can infiltrate into various state and political structures by corruption and directly or indirectly by influencing democratic development in the countries. Assuming all these facts, it is necessary to fight against organized criminal groups cooperatively and not separately.

Adequate response to social, political, and economic issues (which are caused by organized crime) requires right understanding of its roots, character, and successfulness of various measures. Without understanding relations between these factors it is not possible to solve the situation effectively. Due to it, it is necessary to analyse activities of the criminal groups, define or evaluate threats of their activities, and to propose and take measures which result in reduction of their operational area (cease to commit crime, etc.).

These facts prompt us to exchange information and experience in the field of security or legal theory and practice.

Scientific and organization committee of the conference is convinced that the ideal way how to do it, is to participate in scientific conference which goals are:

- to analyse current and assumed trends associated with criminal group activities operating in the Central European Region,
- to identify issues which are known in the processes of detection, clarification, and investigation of crimes committed by the members of criminal groups.

By active participation at the scientific conference the participants are expected to contribute to development of international cooperation in the fight against organized crime.
