The aim of the conference is to focus on some important milestones for Czechoslovak statehood, the genesis of the First Czechoslovak Republic, important events connected with the role of the state as well as the establishment of independent republics. The importance of the conference lies in presenting results of scientific research and progress and in providing a useful forum for a wide-ranging specialist discussion on various issues related to Czechoslovak statehood, the evolution of legislation and areas of law spreading into new fields of the life of society. The conference will also examine the development of security issues in the specified period, the formation of security forces and police.

Conference themes:

- 1 The Czechoslovak Republic (social, political and economic development)
- 2 Czechoslovakia's foreign policy
- 3 The development of the Czechoslovak state and law (formation of the legal order, organization of courts, public prosecution etc.)
- 4 The status of nationalities and ethnic minorities since the formation of Czechoslovakia
- 5 The constitutional and political development (on our territory) since 1918
- 6 The development of public administration (on our territory) for the last 100 years
- 7 The status of the citizen and of the man in the social environment (social, political, economic, societal, psychological, non-material and moral aspects in the historical context)
- 8 Fundamental rights and freedoms – their genesis and inclusion in constitutions throughout history (since 1918)
- 9 The development of police after 1918 (the development of investigation for the last 100 years, progress in forensic science etc.)
- 10 The history of European police corps (historical and legal aspects)
- 11 The development of police officers' service
- 12 The development of service actions carried out in critical situations in police practice
- 13 The genesis of the legal order (areas of public law and of private law)
- 14 Penal law and its development in the historical context
- 15 The history of crime committed on our territory since the formation of Czechoslovakia
- 16 Slovak (Czechoslovak) criminology in the 20th and 21st centuries (current issues, innovations, prevention)
- 17 Schools and education in the field of security forces – the teaching of specialist subjects related to security and law
- 18 The milestones in our history occurring in years ending with an 8

The conference will also look at history through a lens of artefacts, photographs, technical means as well as an exhibition of uniforms. Conference participants will have an ideal opportunity to become familiar with the genesis of selected means applied in police and security practice and to be confronted with the progress which has been achieved up to the present.
