Forensic odorology. Identification of the person's scent traces using the scented cans method of training.6. Probative value of the person's scent trace from the point of view of criminal proceedings.7. Mantrailing method and its use in operation and investigative activity of the police force.8. Police hippology and its use in riot police and border patrol activities9. Mounted police intervention using different police force services - mounted riot police service, border patrol service.10. Veterinary care and breeding of dogs. Criminal liability of dog owners.11. Material and technical support of police kynology and hippology at the police force.
